The Sporting Licenses must be issued by the competitor's National Air-sports Control (NAC) affiliated with the Fédération Aéronautique Internationale (FAI).

Protest

A protest fee of Euro 40.00 is required. The fee will be returned only if the protest is upheld.

Awards

CIAM Medals will be awarded to the top three individual winners and top three winning teams.

In addition, trophies will be awarded to the top three team winners.



The Competition Site

The competition site will be the Cebu Aero-modelers Club's flying field. Cebu City is the second biggest city in the Philippines located at the south of the country. It is usually referred to as the capital of the south.

The Cebu City government awarded Cebu Aero-modelers Club part of a 300 hectare land area for aero-modeling use. The runway and helipad has been positioned parallel to the runway of the Cebu International airport. For special events, some parts of the land area may be used as a practice field. The site is located 12km from the airport and 5km from downtown Cebu.

The helipad is designed with a contest area layout as specified in the FAI Sporting Code Section 4 F3C Volume 2007.

Precedence

The Cebu Aero-modelers Club has organized several local and national events on their air field. Their air field was also the venue of a successful international event, the Hirobo Cup Asia 2007, with 38 competitors from 7 countries participating.



The Venue: Cebu City

Cebu is the 2nd largest island? of the Philippines. Its capital is **Cebu City**, the oldest city in the Philippines and it is one of the most developed provinces of the country. It is the main center of commerce, trade, education and industry in the central and southern parts of the archipelago.



Cebu City is visitor and tourist friendly. It has its own international airport with several flights daily into and out of the country. Several international hotels are present in the city offering world class services and facilities.

Transportation Around Cebu

Car rentals and taxis are available all over the city at very reasonable cost. Taxis are available throughout the city with a flag down of PhP30.00 or Euro 0.46 and PhP2.50 or Euro 0.038

These hotels provide world class accommodation and service at very reasonable rates. These hotels are situated about 15 to 20 minutes from the competition site.

Meals

International cuisine ranging from Japanese, Western to European food are available from many restaurants around the city. Average cost per meal is between Euro 8.00 to Euro 12.00.

Airport

Cebu City boast its own international airport. Direct flights to and from Cebu City are available from Hong Kong, Singapore, Korea, Taiwan to name a few.

The Airport is located on Lapu Lapu Island, 15 Minutes away from the center of Cebu City.



Events such as the 2008 F3C Asian Oceanic Championship are supported by the Cebu City Government. Special arrangements in customs will be prepared for trouble free entrance of equipment.

AOCC Competition Site

The 2008 AOCC competition will be held in the South Properties just in the perimeter of Metro Cebu City. The competition site is situated approximately 20 minutes from the organizer's recommended hotels, Marco Polo and Casa Rosario, and approximately 45 minutes from the Mactan International Airport.



Facilities and amenities at the competition site

1. Refreshments Stalls
