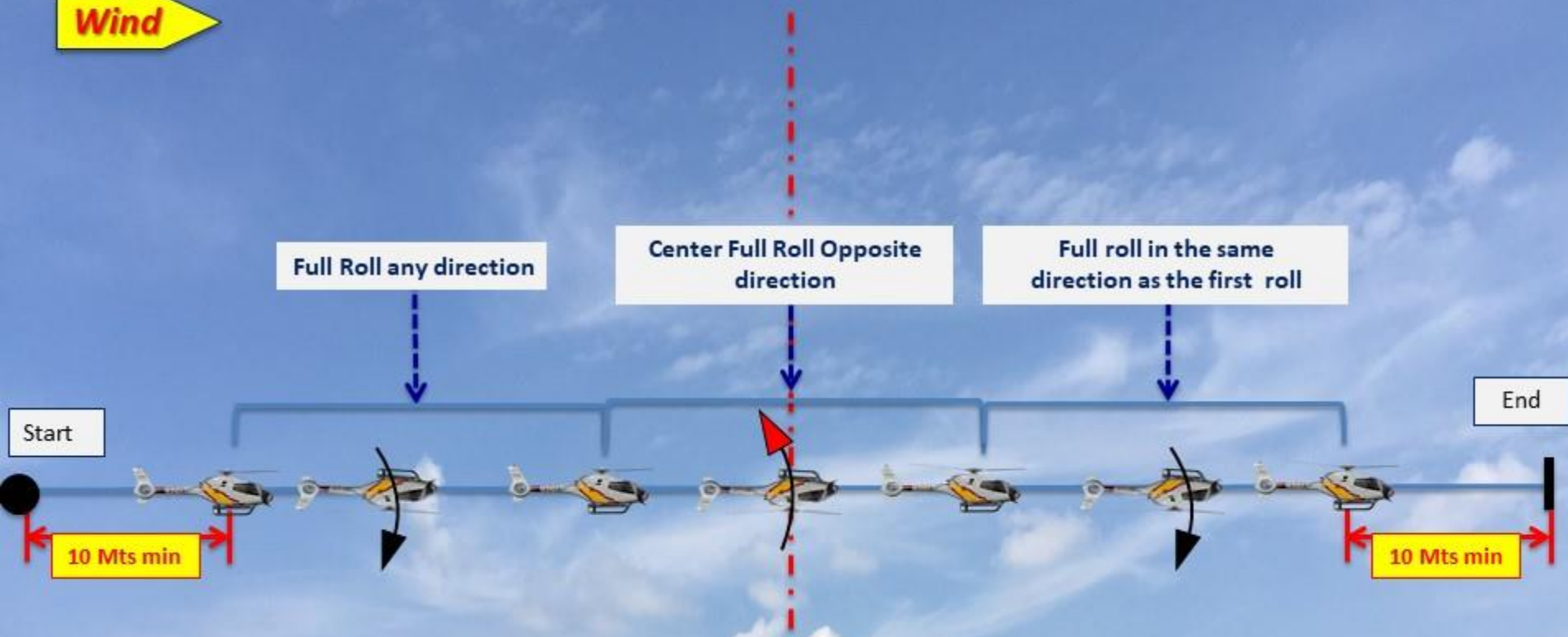
## F6-Three opposite rolls

## F6. Three Opposite Rolls (DD)

### F5: Three opposite rolls (DD)

MA flies straight and level for a minimum of 10m, performs a roll in any direction followed by a roll in opposite direction followed by a roll in the same direction as the first roll.

MA flies straight and level for a minimum of 10m.

**Note 1:** During the second roll the MA must be in inverted flight when it crosses the center line.

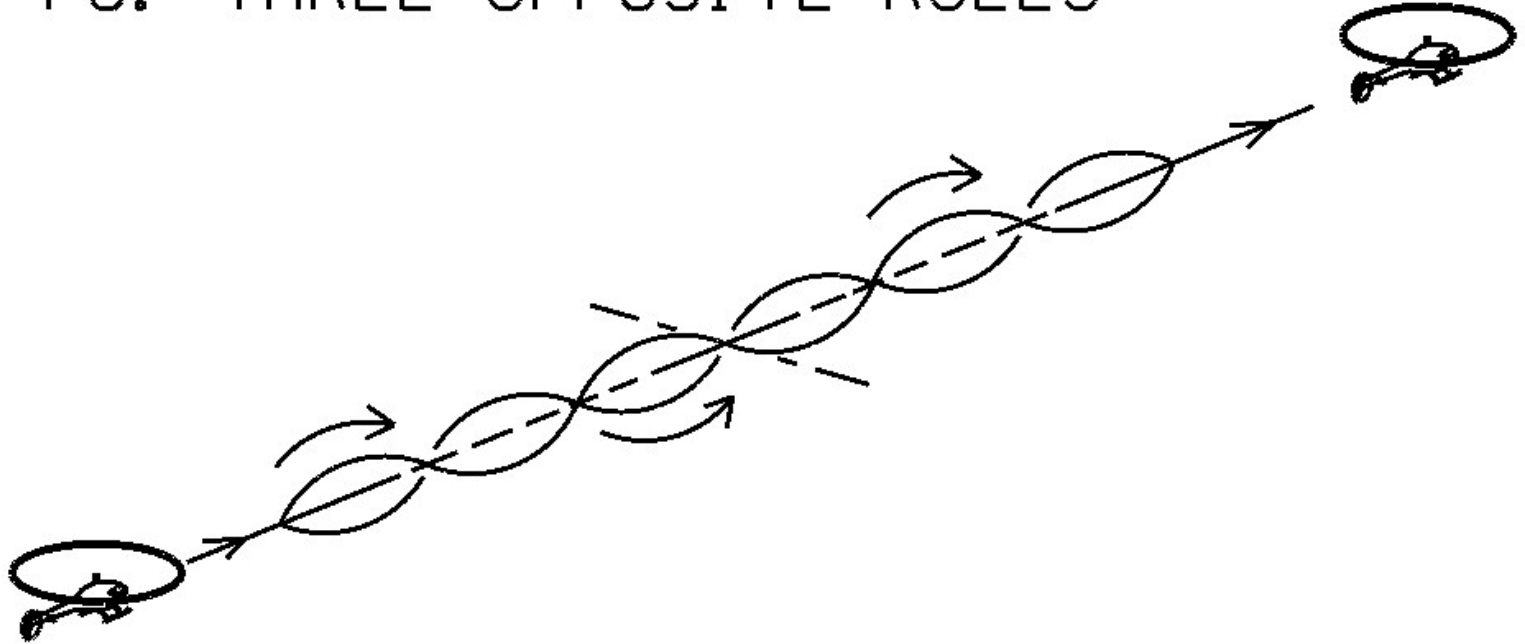
**Note 2:** The rolls must be executed one immediately after the other, straight flights between the rolls will be downgraded by one to two points.

**Note 3:** The elapsed time from the beginning of the first to the end of the third roll must be at least 4 seconds.

#### Comments :

Aside from note 1, nothing special except that the trajectory must be straight and parallel to the judges' line. The three rolls must be linked.
