All participants of the F3C/F3N event shall assure their acceptance of the FAI Anti-Doping Rules with their signature on the "Acknowledgement and Agreement" form to present during registration.

Direct qualification

The reigning World ... Champion has the right (subject to the approval of his NAC /National Airsports Control) to participate in the next World ... Championships in that category regardless of whether he qualifies for the national team or not. If he is not a member of the national team, his score will not be considered in the team results. /acc. to B.3.5 and B.3.4 SC ABR 2013/

Licensing

Each competitor, team manager and assistant team manager must possess a FAI Sporting License, valid for 2013, issued by their NAC.

10. CLASSIFICATIONS AND AWARDS

There will be two independent individual and team classifications.

Winners will be awarded with FAI medals and diplomas and the Organisers prizes.

18. PROTESTS

Rules

All protests must be presented in writing to the Sports Director at the competition site, and must be accompanied by a deposit of the fee. The fee is 35 € according to FAI Sporting Code Section 4 Aeromodelling, Volume ABR 2013 Edition.

Return of deposit

The deposit is returned if the protest is upheld only.

19. MODELS PROCESSING

FAI Specification Certificate

Each competitor must present a valid FAI SPECIFICATION CERTIFICATE for his model /s/ from his NAC, according to FAI Sporting Code Section 4 Aeromodelling, Volume ABR 2013 Edition

Important note

Model aircraft not properly processed by NAC, must be processed by the organiser at a cost of 8€ for each model.

20. NATIONAL FLAGS AND ANTHEMS

Team manager duties

The Team Manager, or any other team member in his place, is kindly requested to bring one flag appr. 1 m \times 1,5 m and a CD with the national anthem.

Collection and return

Flag and CD will be collected during the team's registration, and returned after the closing ceremony.

21. REGISTRATION OF PARTICIPANTS

Time and place of registration

Registration of participants will take place in the Contest Office according to the Official Schedule.

During registration the Team Managers must present:

- Competitors and Team Manager FAI Licenses;
- Final Entry Form signed and stamped by the National Air Sports Control;
- Copy of the teams banking payment receipt;
- Model Certificates to present for model processing;
- Signed "Athlete's Acknowledgement and Agreement of FAI Antidoping Rules";
- One national flag 1.0 m * 1.5 m;
- One CD or USB stick with national anthem MP3 format;
- F3N Set manoeuvres for Round 1 if not sent by email /F3N only/.

Note: For FAI Licences that do not carry photographs or the date of birth then valid photographic the ID is required.

During the registration the Team Manager will receive:

- ID cards for all team members
- Vehicle passes to enter
- Banquet invitation cards.*)

22. ENTRY FORMS

Photographs

Preliminary Entry Form

The preliminary Entry Form signed by NAC and stamped with NAC stamp, must be sent by post, e-mail or fax **no later than March 20th, 2013**.

Final Entry Form

The Final Entry Form typed or written in block letters, signed and stamped with NAC, photographs must be sent by post, e-mail or fax **no later than April 30th, 2013.**

23. FREQENCIES

Strongly recommended 2.4 GHz transmitters have to fulfill European Standard EN 300328. The maximum equivalent emission power EIRP is 100 mW peak. The transmitter must be CE marked and bear the declaration of conformity. Other transmitters for model aircraft are accepted on demand and must use the legal frequencies approved by Electronic Communication Office /UKE/ in Poland in the 35 MHz-Band. **See the list of frequencies on the FAI website** /see http://www.fai.org/ciam-our-sport/frequencies/.

24. FUEL FOR MODELS

Purchasing

Competitors can order to the Organizers fuel for practice and contest purposes. See Fuel Order Form available at the official championships website.

Shipping

Fuel for F3C and F3N models can be shipped to the Organizers.

The responsibility for on time delivery of fuel to the contest site lies on contestants.

The Organizers are responsible for arranging safe storage for this fuel.
