SCHEDULE: Attached in graphical form is the official events schedule for Chopper Champs 85. You will note a significant change in the events schedule from the preliminary release. Registration for F3C should be completed by Sunday 14 July 1985 12:00 hours.

If you wish to practice fly before 13 July 1985 arrangements can be made at local flying sites. Awards will be presented on the field immediately following the completion of the last flight.

All transmitters are to be submitted for frequency measurement on Sunday 14 July 1985 at 10:00 hours.

OPENING CEREMONY: At 12:00 hours on Sunday 14 July 1985 there will be a brief opening ceremony where each team manager will raise the flag of his nation. This ceremony will be at the site and the flags will be provided by the organizers.

FLIGHT ORDER: Due to the fact that all frequency information has not been received, the flight order will not be established until Sunday 14 July 1985 at 12:00 hours. It will be established by random draw with corrections for consecutive identical frequencies. F3C will be rotated forward by one third of the competitors each day, but retaining the originally established order.

RULES: Attached for your information is a complete set of updated rules and score sheets which will be used for your particular event during the competition.

FUEL: Will be provided on site, up to two gallons per competitor of fuel of your own choice using either Klotz or Castor Oil, or synthetic. This will be custom blended to your request. Send us a card with your requirements and it will be ready for you when you arrive. Approximate price will be \$14.00 cdn. per 4 liters.
