INVITATION

All National Airsports Controls (NAC's) in Europe, affiliated to the Fédération Aéronautique Internationale (FAI) are invited to participate in the European Championships 1996 for F3C R/C Helicopters.

ORGANIZER

The Finnish Aeronautical Association/FAA (Suomen Ilmailuliitto/SIL), by appointment of FAI.

TIME AND PLACE

From August 4th to 11th, 1996, in the town of NURMES in East Finland, 550 kilometres northeast of Helsinki and 120 kilometres east of Kuopio.

PARTICIPANTS

Each European member of the FAI may send a team of;

- Team Manager
- 3 competitors
- official helpers
- supporters
- press representatives

Mr. Daniele Graber of Switzerland will not be limited by the rule above if he will participate as the ruling European Champion.

CONTEST RULES

The contest will be run according the FAI Sporting Code, Section 4b - General, and Section 4c - Aeromodels, Part 5, 5.4 Class F3C.

EVENTS Both individual and team classification. Winners will be awarded with medals, diplomas and trophies.
