

LOCATION:



Location (Flying Site)

Bryanston School (Blandford Forum, Dorset, DT11 0PX) is located approximately twenty-four miles southwest of Salisbury and fourteen miles northwest of Poole. The School is situated in a 400-acre estate with extensive playing fields. The flying site will be located within the grounds. *IMPORTANT, PLEASE NOTE:* no dogs are allowed within the grounds of Bryanston School.
