
We invite all F3C pilots to join the Austrian World Cup event 2024 in Carinthia!

Number of flights:

Up to 15 registered pilots - We plan to perform 3 "P" flights and 2 "F" flights Over 15 registered pilots - All pilots perform 3" P" flights with the Top 10 pilots performing 2 "F" flights

Subject to time constraints and number of entrants, there may be the opportunity to fly an additional round of the P Schedule or if additional pilots wish to attempt the F schedule. This can be decided at the pilot's briefing and once we have an accurate weather forecast for the weekend.

Flight Order:

Randomly selected by the computer prior to the start of the competition.

Calibration Flights:

Calibration flight for P Schedule will be selected at random and performed by one of the pilots present during the last World Championship. Calibration flight for F Schedule will be performed by pilot ranked 10th in the preliminary rounds.

In case a competitor has to take any of the substances listed on the WADA Prohibited List for medical treatment then he must have a Therapeutic Use Exemption from the FAI.

Awards:

A Diploma will be awarded to all competitors.
