Euro Heli Series

FRANCE – 27/28/29 June 2025

Introduction:

We are pleased to announce that the 2025 French Euro Heli Series competition will be held in La Commune de la Hague, near Cherbourg, Northern France. The competition will be hosted by the HMAc (Hague Modèle Air Club) and the FFAM (Fédération Française d'Aéromodélisme).

We invite all current FAI F3C pilots to compete in this round of the 2025 Euro Heli Series competition.

Number of flights:

All pilots perform 4" P" flights with the top 15 pilots performing 2 "F" flights. There may be the opportunity to fly additional rounds of the P Schedule or for all pilots to fly the F schedule should they wish. This will be decided before the pilot's briefing once we have an accurate weather forecast for the weekend and know the number of participants.

Flight Order:

Randomly selected by the computer before the start of the competition.

Calibration Flights:

The calibration flight for P Schedule will be completed by the last pilot to fly in the 1st round as the flight order is randomly selected by the F3Scoring application.

For the F Schedule, the calibration flight will be performed by the pilot ranked 16th in the preliminary rounds. If all pilots fly the F Schedule, the calibration flight will be completed by the last pilot to fly in the 1st round of F, as the flight order is randomly selected by the F3Scoring application.

Competitors:

This competition is registered with the FAI. All current FAI-registered F3C pilots are invited to register.

Competition Rules:

The competition will be run in accordance with the FAI Sporting Code (including ranking), Section 4, 2025 Edition in addition to all applicable amendments.

Safety:

The competition director may randomly select pilots to demonstrate that the failsafe is correctly set on their models.

Protests:

All protests must be presented in writing to the Contest Director at the competition site and must be accompanied by a deposit of 50€. The deposit will only be returned if the protest is upheld.

Awards:

A Euro Heli Series Diploma will be awarded to all competitors. Trophies will be awarded for 1st, 2nd and 3rd place.

Official Language: Official language will be French/English.

Pilot's Registration:

The maximum number of pilots will be 25 to ensure enough time to complete the rounds. Registration will only be confirmed once a registration form and full entry fee of €90 have been received. The entry fee must be paid in accordance with the registration policy on the Euro Heli Series website.

Registration for the competition is to be done by completing the electronic form on the F3scoring website. A link can be found on the Euro Heli Series website (<http://euroheliseries.net/registration>). Your name will be added to the list once the registration is complete and the full entry fee is received.
