We invite all current FAI registered F3C pilots to come and compete in this round of the 2023 F3C Euro Heli Series World Cup.




Venue:

Practice Field: Not available

Field Elevation: Approximately 15 feet above sea level

Electricity: Electricity is available at the field for charging.

Number of flights:

All pilots perform 3" P" flights with the top 10 pilots performing 2 "F" flights. Subject to time and number of entrants, there may be the opportunity to fly an additional round of the P Schedule or for all pilots to fly the F schedule should they wish. This will be decided at the pilot's briefing and once we have an accurate weather forecast for the weekend and know the number of participants.

Flight Order:

Randomly selected by the computer prior to the start of the competition.

Calibration Flights:

Calibration flight for P Schedule will be completed by the last pilot to fly in the 1st round as the flight order is randomly selected.

Calibration flight for F Schedule will be performed by pilot ranked 11th in the preliminary rounds. If all pilots should fly the F Schedule, the calibration flight will be completed by the last pilot to fly in the 1st round of F, as the flight order is randomly selected.

Competitors:

This is an FAI registered F3C World Cup Open Competition, all current FAI registered F3C pilots are invited to register.

Competition Rules:

In accordance with the FAI Sporting Code (including ranking), Section 4, 2023 Edition as well as all applicable amendments.

Safety:

The competition director may randomly select pilots to demonstrate that failsafe is correctly set on their models.

Protests:

All protests must be presented in writing to the Contest Director at the competition site and must be accompanied by a deposit of 50€. The deposit will only be returned if the protest is upheld.

Awards:

A Euro Heli Series Diploma will be awarded to all competitors. Trophies will be awarded for 1^{st} , 2^{nd} and 3^{rd} place.

Official Language:

Official language will be English.

Entry Fee: €90 Seniors / €40 Juniors

Pilot's Registration:

The maximum number of pilots will be 20 to ensure there is enough time to complete the rounds. Registration will only be confirmed once a registration form and a deposit of €40 have been received. The remainder of the entry fee must be made before 01 March 2023, or the place may be offered to a pilot on the reserve list.
