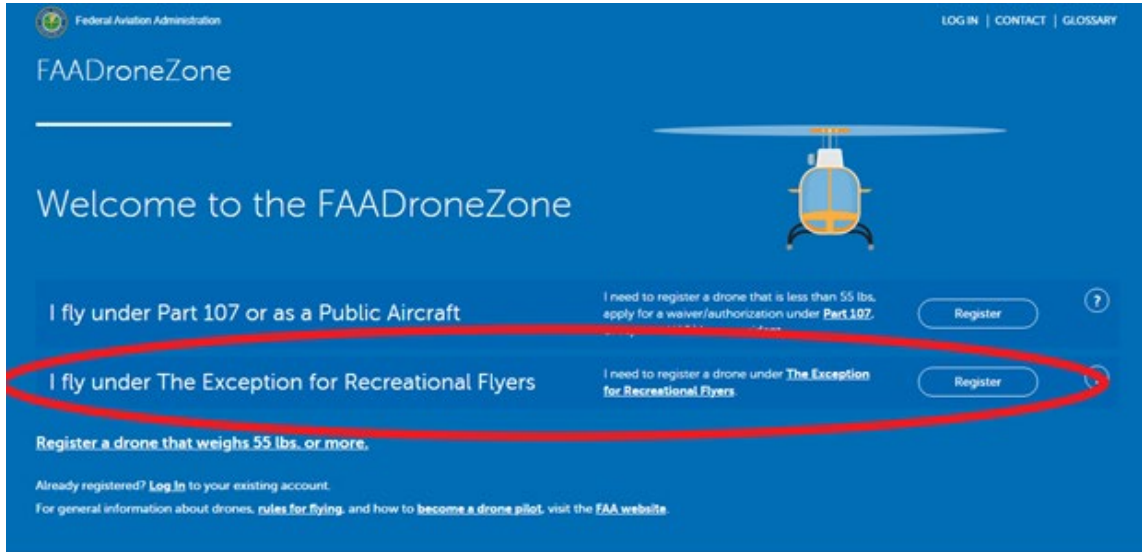




Registering with the FAA and taking TRUST

For International UAS Pilots





Create an Account

- faadronezone.faa.gov
- Register with the “I fly under The Exception for Recreational Flyers” option

You must use the paper (N-number) registration process if

- Your unmanned aircraft is 55 pounds or greater
- You want to qualify a small unmanned aircraft for operation outside the United States
- You hold title to an aircraft in trust
- The small unmanned aircraft owner uses a voting trust to meet U.S. Citizenship requirements

To register you must be 13 years of age or older. Use a valid email address as you will need to verify your account.

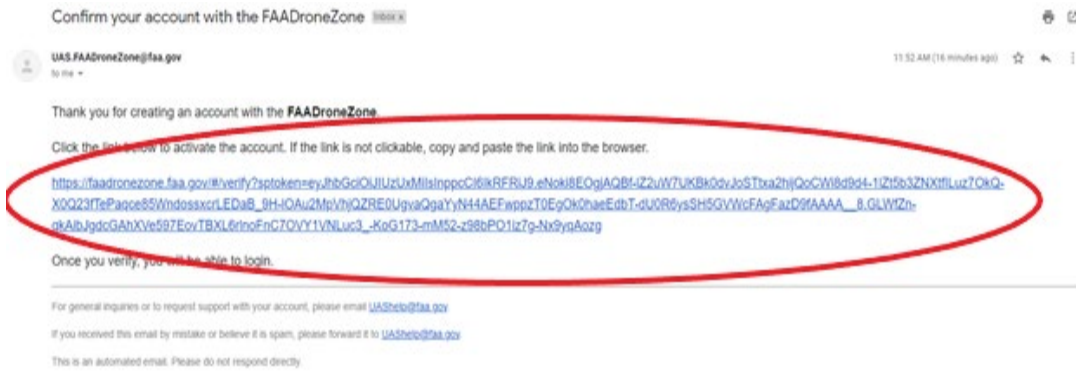
Password must be at least 8 characters in length and contain at least one upper case letter, one lower case letter, one number, and one special character (e.g. !, @, #, %, etc.).

REGISTRATION FEE

- The registration fee is \$5.00.

REGISTRATION NUMBER

- When you register, you will receive a registration number that applies to all unmanned aircraft you own and operate under the Exception for Recreational Flyers.
- Registrations are valid for 3 years. After 3 years, you must renew your registration.
- You must mark the outside of all unmanned aircraft with your registration number before you operate them.

THE EXCEPTION FOR RECREATIONAL FLYERS

To fly under [The Exception for Recreational Flyers](#), you must:

- Have a current registration
- Fly only for recreational purposes
- Follow the safety guidelines of a community based organization
- Keep your drone within your visual line of sight
- Give way and do not interfere with any manned aircraft
- Fly at or below 400' in controlled airspace and only with prior authorization
- Fly at or below 400' in uncontrolled airspace
- Comply with all airspace restrictions
- Pass The Recreational UAS Safety Test (Coming Soon)

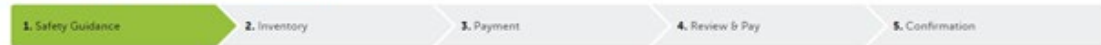

Your Inventory

Recreational flyers must add manufacturer and model information for all UAS over 0.55 pounds that they own and operate. For standard remote identification (sID) or broadcast modules, you'll also be required to provide the serial number. Each broadcast module serial number may only be entered once to your inventory, even if shared with more than one recreational UAS.

To continue the registration process, you must have at least one active device in your inventory.
