# AERO – CLUB of SWITZERLAND WORLD CHAMPIONSHIP F3C JUNE 29. – JULY 4. 1987 BERNE – SWITZERLAND

Dear Pilots, Team Managers, Helpers and Friends!

The AERO - CLUB of SWITZERLAND and the organizing committee of the World Champion-ship F3C are very glad to welcome you in Berne for the WC F3C. We all hope to have a nice time together. With this paper we inform you about the program of WC F3C in Berne. For those teams who will arrive earlier, there will be a possibility to fly on the training field, about 15 Kilometers away from the airfield. It is not allowed to fly on the contest field before Sunday ( June 28. ). The program is as follows:

#### SATURDAY (JUNE 27.)

On this day the oranizing committee finishes the infrastructure for WC F3C. On the same day the "Judges Course" is being held at the Airport Hotel.

#### SUNDAY (JUNE 28.)

During the day it is possible to fly on the contest field without an official frequency controll. There will be a panel with clips so you can occupy and controll your chanel. Every day between 12.00 to 13.30 o'clock it is not allowed to fly. At 17.00 o'clock (5.00 PM) the official opening ceremony will start. During the ceremony the official start order for the training of each country on Monday will be decided by drawing lots.

#### MONDAY (JUNE 29.)

Until  $07.^{45}$  o'clock (  $7.^{45}$  AM ) every pilot have to bring his transmiter to the depot. At  $08.^{00}$  o'clock (  $8.^{00}$  AM ) the first country has half an hour of training time. Each country will have half an hour of training time during the day. At  $10.^{30}$  o'clock (  $10.^{30}$  AM ) the training will be interrupted for a 30 minutes demonstration for the press. After the training of each country, pilots have to give their models for checking. Starting this day until Sunday, lunch and supper is served in the hangar at the contest area by catering sevice. The daily lunch break is between  $12.^{90}$  –  $13.^{30}$  o'clock.

#### TUESDAY (JUNE 30.) to FRIDAY (JULY 3.)

Each day an official competition flight will be flown. On each day the transmiters have to be in the depot at 07.45 o'clock (7.45 AM). The round starts at 08.00 o'clock (8.00 AM).

#### SATURDAY (JULY 4.)

At 09.00 o'clock the air show starts. The whole day (except 12.00 - 13.30 o'clock) will be a flying demonstration for the spectators. In the afternoon will be the official winners announcement in front of the spectators. The award banquet will be held at the Ambassador Hotel after 18.00 o'clock (6.00 PM). During the award banquet we will also announce the ranks of all participants. All pilots or teams who want to make a demonstration flight during this day should inform us at least until Friday so we can organize it. With the award banquet the World Championship F3C comes to an end, but we hope friendship will remain.

#### HOW TO COME TO THE CONTEST AERA?

The world championship will be held on the airport of Berne, located near the village of Belp. It is situated about 9 Km south/east of the city of Berne. Those who will come by car to Berne should stay on the super high way direction." Berne ". Arriving in Berne do not leave the super high way, follow the direction." INTERLAKEN." About 9 Km later take the exit. "RUBIGEN / BELP / MÜNSINGEN." Follow the indication. BELP " with the small sign of an airplane. In the village of Belp follow the sign with the airplane and you will arrive at the airfield. It will be always somebody there to welcome you and give you further informations. For those who arrive late in the night or those who want to go to the hotel directly (HOTEL AMBASSADOR) do not follow the sign with the airplane in the village of Belp but go strait ahead direction city of BERNE. After the city indication." BERN. There will be two seperate Tramway lines on the left side out of the street, by the next traffic light turn right, and you are in front of the Ambassador Hotel. Those who will arrive in Switzerland by plane on the airports of "ZÜRICH." or "GENEVA" we offer to pick you up if we know the date, flight Nr. and time of arrival.


#### CAR RENTALS.


There are many car rentals in Berne, the nearest is 100 meters besides the hotel ( Hertz ).
