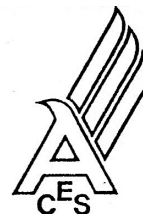

Dear F3C judges.

The AERO - CLUB of SWITZERLAND will organize the 1. int. F3C judge - course from June 27. and 28. 1987 at the Airport of Bern- Belp. At the same place the 2. WC F3C will be held on June 29. to July 4. 1987. The aim is to achieve an equal standard in giving scores for later continental and world championships.

We hope that each country which has active F3C pilots will send a delegation of about 3 persons (experts, specialists and international F3C judges) to attend the course.

The following points will be treated:

Saturday, June 27. at 9.⁰⁰ AM.

Opening welcome and introduction of the different speakers by the Aero - Club of Switzerland.

Speaker: HAGEN Horace, USA.

Retrospection of the European championship 1984 in Eibergen (NL), the World championship 1985 in London (CDN) and the European championship 1985 in Toulouse (F).

Speaker: DE PROFT Francis, Belgium.

Clarify the present FAI F3C code. Proposals to change and improve the present rules in order to make them distinct and to guarantee security. Standardize the number of points to be deducted for mistakes.

Sunday, June 28. at 9.⁰⁰ AM.

Speaker: HADORN Rudolf, Switzerland.

Advantages and disadvantages of open scoring according to his experiences of two continental - and one world champ.

Discussion with the different speakers. In the afternoon, training by judging flights on the contest field for the WC F3C 1987.
