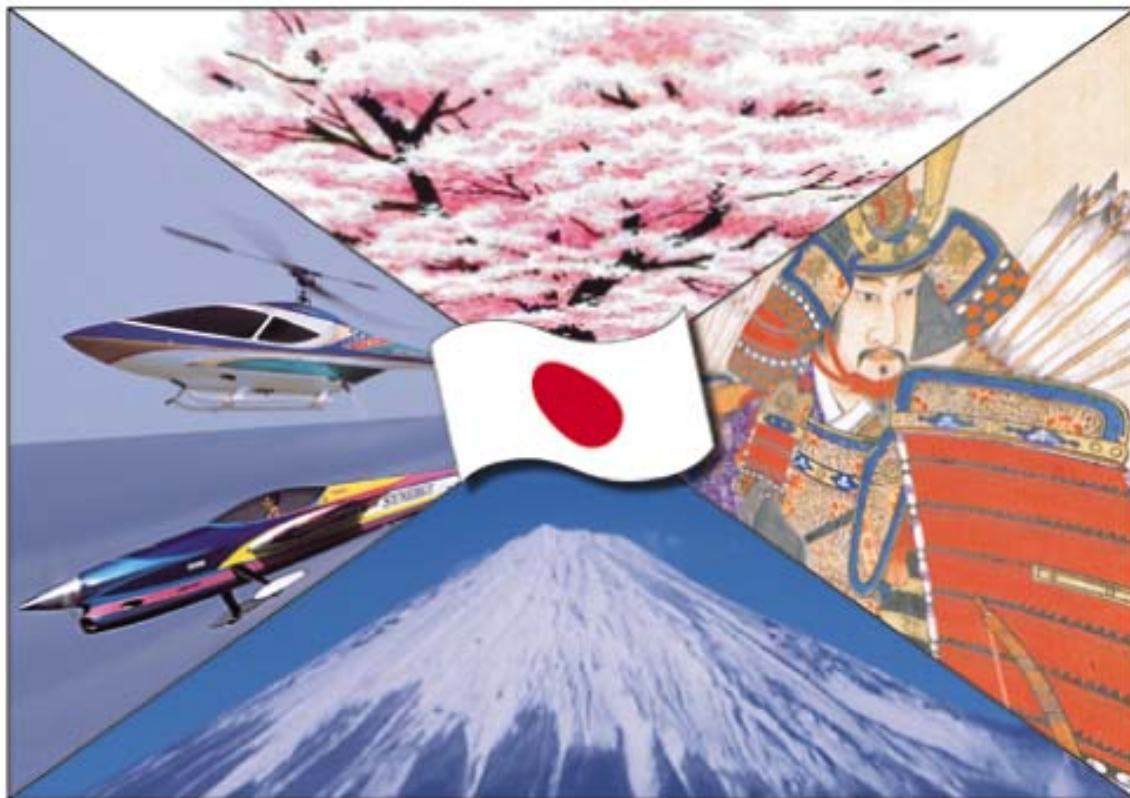

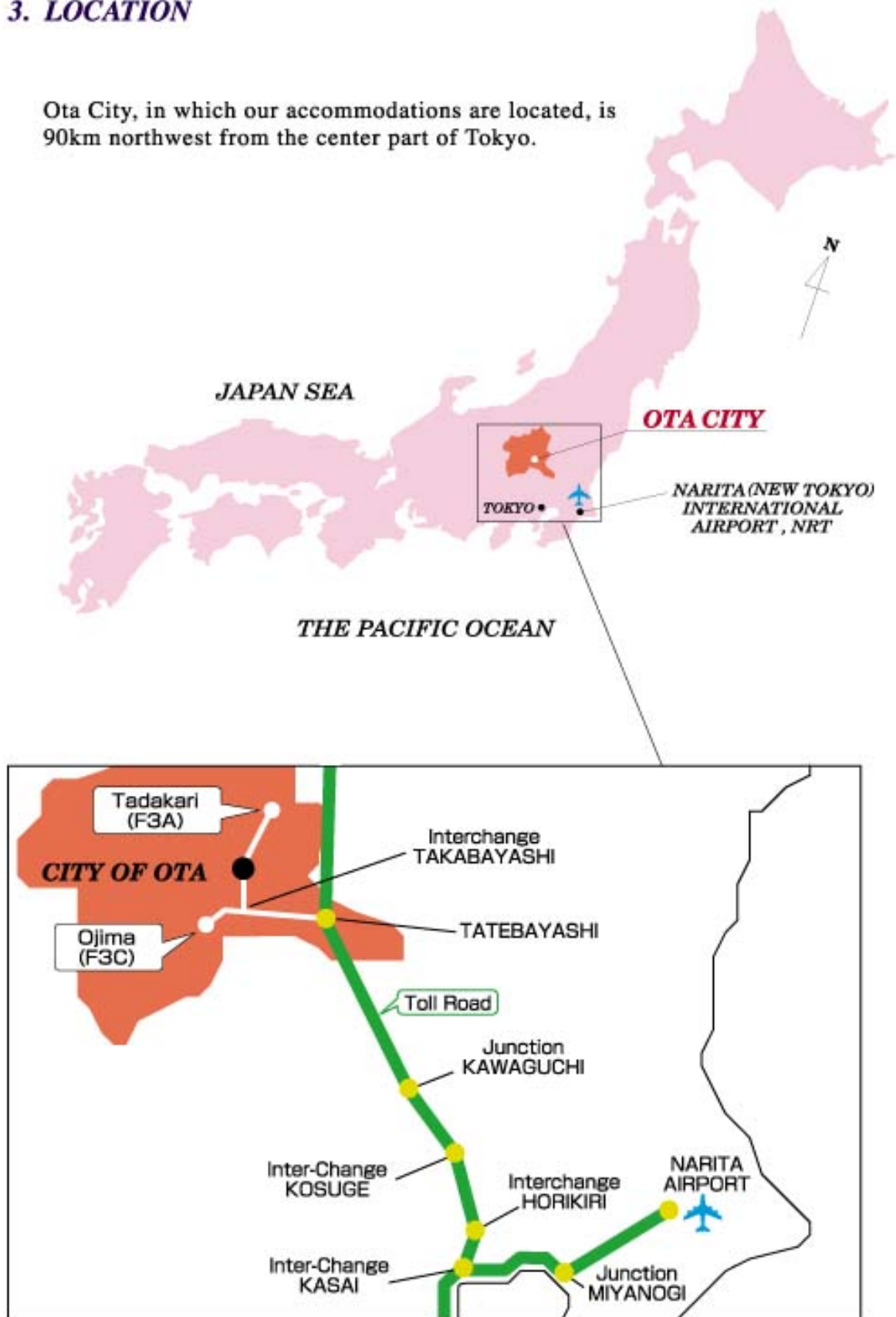

7. OFFICIAL ENTRY

The official entry form must be filled in and received by the organizing committee no later than 30 April,2006. (Please only send application by POST, as many facsimile transmissions arrive partly or fully unreadable). When sending the official entry forms, please ensure that the National Airsports Control stamp is clearly visible, those that arrive without the stamp on, cannot be accepted for entry.

In order to produce ID cards and programs for the CAOCC, we require one (1) 24 x 30mm color photo from all team members. The photo should be taken from the shoulders up. Please write your name in PENCIL on the back of each photo. In the case where by digital photo are sent by email, please ensure that the highest quality mode is used to enable us to print the photo to the highest possible quality. Thank you.

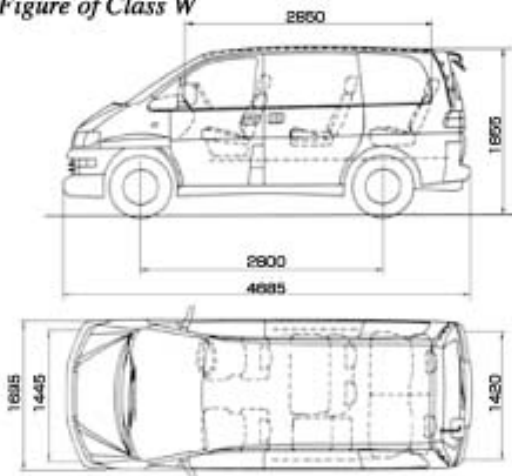

17. TRANSPORTATION

From New Tokyo International Airport (Narita Airport - NRT) to Ota Station, participants can take either Airport Limousine bus or rental vehicles. We highly recommend participants the use of Airport Limousine bus directly going to Ota Station, since you have to get through the traffic of center part of Tokyo which is extremely complex on the way to Ota City. Participants can get the rental vehicles upon arrival in Ota City. Also, It is only a minute walk from Ota Station.

There are four Airport Limousine buses daily from Narita Airport to Ota Station and vise versa.
